

# Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

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80km from Vic Falls Airport - 8 rooms



## Imbabala **NEW**

**LOCATION:** Imbabala Lodge is 80 kilometers west of Victoria Falls and is located at the meeting point of Botswana, Zambia, Zimbabwe and Namibia. It is situated on the edge of the Zambezi River bank and snuggles into riverside vegetation which makes it one of the best game viewing and bird watching areas. Chobe National Park is adjacent to Imbabala Lodge and large herds of elephant, buffalo and other wildlife can be viewed.

**ACCOMMODATION:** A maximum of 18 guests are accommodated at Imbabala Lodge, which makes guests' stay a personalized and exclusive experience. The 8 chalets (5 twin-bedded suites, 2 honeymoon suites and 1 family double-room) all have en-suite facilities and each has a view of the Zambezi River. The rooms are decorated according to an individual theme and guests have choices between the luxury lodge, forest lodge, safari lodge and honeymoon. All the rooms have fans and mosquito nets. Disabled facilities are available.

**FACILITIES:** There is a swimming pool to cool guests down after a long exciting day under the African sun. Meals can be taken in the dining

room or al fresco. Imbabala Lodge is renowned for their high culinary standards.

There are plenty of activities available for guests to enjoy, which include 4-wheel drive game viewing safaris, fishing, walking through the bush with an armed guide on hand, and river cruises.

## The Hide

**LOCATION:** The Hide is one of the few camps to be situated inside Hwange National Park. Unlike most other camps in Zimbabwe, no long drives to the park are necessary. The 45 minute drive from Hwange Main Camp to the camp takes you through the National Park, serving as an introductory game drive and your first taste of the Zimbabwean safari.

**ACCOMMODATION:** Guests stay in comfortably furnished tents, each with its own en-suite bathroom with hot water shower, basin and flush toilet. Each tent has its own private verandah looking out over the waterhole.

**FACILITIES:** Situated beside a waterhole, the camp is truly a paradise for game viewing. A wide variety of game can be seen in the camp's immediate vicinity, and this often includes elephant, lion and rhino. One of the highlights at The Hide are the two specially constructed hides near the waterholes, where game can be viewed at close proximity. The camp's central feature is the large thatch A-frame dining area with upstairs entertainment section offering magnificent views. The Hide has earned a reputation over the years for its fine cuisine. Meals are a friendly and relaxed affair, with guests and their hosts all sitting down together

to chat and eat around a grand teak table. The professional guides will take you through the National Park, where you will come face to face with lions, elephants and giraffes, amongst a host of other game.
