<p><b>Plitvice Lakes - Join us to enjoy the magic beauty of the lakes and waterfalls, creating spectacular scenery.</b></p> <p>Situated in a thick forest, Plitvice Lakes are considered one of the most beautiful natural phenomena in the world. Sixteen lakes, connected by 92 waterfalls, cascade through its picturesque surrounding. Plitvice Lakes were declared a National Park in 1949, and since 1979, they have been on the UNESCO's List of World Natural Heritage.</p> <p>Walking tour is with a guide. Wooden paths will take you along 16 enchanting lakes. River Korana creates beautiful waterfalls, lakes and caves that make this National park one of the most precious natural sights in Croatia. Every season offers a unique experience, giving you the chance to enjoy this untouched nature.</p> <p>After arriving to the lake Kozjak you will continue with the boat across the lake, and then follow the paths of this fairyland towards the lake Prošćansko. <p><b>River Krka Waterfalls &amp; Šibenik</b></p> <p>A pleasant coach drive through the karsts hinterland of Šibenik Riviera takes us to the first stop -city of Šibenik.</p> <p>Šibenik is the oldest Croatian town on the Adriatic coast. It is also called Krešimir's town, since it was the residence of King Petar Krešimir IV, the most important ruler of the ancient Croatian state. It grew from an old Croatian fort near the fortress of St. Michael, which still overlooks the town. Upon arrival, you can enjoy sightseeing one of the most valuable sacral monuments in Dalmatia – The St. James' Cathedral dating from the 15 century. After visiting Šibenik continue to ride to the famous waterfalls of the River Krka. Here, in beautiful natural surroundings, the River Krka forms picturesque waterfalls cascading over 17 natural barriers. We will visit the restored ethnological monuments to become better acquainted with the customs of the region. The preserved watermills are from the 19th century and have exceptional cultural and historical significance. You will see presentations that will take you back to the 19<sup>th</sup> century. We will walk along the wooden paths to Skradinski buk-the longest and the loveliest waterfall on the krka river. <p><b>Rafting on Cetina River</b></p> <p>As a combination of adventure, sport and fun, has reached its top success just here, in Omis. You don't have to go far from the sea to meet the charm of the River; just few kilometers upstream from the mouth of Cetina begins three hours trip-adventure through picturesque river cuts, dancing waterfalls and rapids, meanwhile offering the clear water surrounded by green woods. 16 km long trip ends in the gorgeous "Radmanove Mlinice"-town green area, where you can rest and enjoy the natural environment, which gives you, with fresh air and specific relief, differing much from the near coast, the picture of Omis, as a small town with great contrasts. And that's what Omis is – small town for pleasant and active holiday.
