<p>3 Days Private Tour Best of Moscow</p> <p>Take this 3 days private tour to see the best of Moscow! Day 1: You will be picked up at your accommodation and will be shown the major highlights of Moscow: Red Square with the famous St. Basil Cathedral, Manezh Square and Tverskaya Street, Poklonnaya Hill and Victory park, dedicated to the great victory of the Soviet Army over the Nazi Germany. Day 2: Today you will explore the heart of Moscow, The Kremlin. <p>City tour and Vodka Factory incl. Vodka tasting</p> <p>Enjoy this vodka tasting experience and learn more about the history of the famous drink.</p> <p>Our Vodka tasting tour will enable guests to learn the story of what real vodka is, when its manufacture began and the role it has played in the history of the Russian civilization. The guests of the museum will have a unique opportunity to see the process of distillation. A large part of the Museum's collection is devoted to the 20th century with all its upheavals. A part of the collection is devoted to the Great Patriotic War in particular to the story of introducing a daily ration of vodka for the soldiers of the 1st line, which is traditionally called "Commissar's 100 Grams". <p>Hop on Hop off Bus (with or without Boat Cruise)</p> <p>Moscow, Russia's capital city is steeped in history and home to 20 million inhabitants. Hop on and off at key locations and explore Moscow at your leisure. The bus tour starts at Moscow's renowned Red Square which is home to the 16th Century St. Basil's Cathedral, one of the most famous pieces of architecture in the world, plus the constructivist pyramid of Lenin's Mausoleum. Travel over Bolshoy Moskvoretsky Bridge, a concrete arch structure which spans the Moscow River and connects the Red Square and Bolshaya Ordynka Street of Zamoskvorechye. The bridge's architect, Alexey Shchusev, chose pink granite as the facade to make the bridge look as if built by real rock. Absorb the history of Balchug street, one of the oldest Moscow streets outside of the Kremlin walls.
