Brief Overview

Discover the joy of unlimited sightseeing and special offers, with the city pass that gives you free entry to the best attractions that Paris has to offer. The Paris Pass also comes with free public transport, covering Zones 1-3, allowing you easy access to the museums and sights included on your Sightseeing Pass. It saves time, as there is no need to stand in ticket lines, and there is no need to use cash. Simply show your pass at the locations included within the scheme and you will be allowed entry.

What is it?

Paris is one of the most spectacular and beautiful cities in the world containing a wealth of history and culture. With countless art galleries, scores of top museums and stunning historical monuments sightseeing in Paris can be a real adventure. The Paris Pass has been specially designed for sightseeing in Paris and includes everything you will need for a great trip whilst saving you both time and money.

How it works?

Once you receive your Paris Pass voucher you then need to take your voucher to a redemption centre in Paris. The address & details of the redemption centre will be on your voucher. Using the Paris Pass couldn't be easier, you simply show your pass at each attraction and then in you go. Save time and money sightseeing in Paris with a Paris Pass.

Your Paris Pass is activated the first time that you use it, but to begin using it you must first sign and date the Paris Pass. After activation your Paris Pass remains valid for the duration that you have purchased.

It is valid on consecutive days and at the end of the validity period, will no longer entitle you to free entry at attractions or transport. If for example, you used a four day pass for the first time on Monday; your pass will cease working at the end of Thursday, regardless of how often you have used it in between. It is important to note that a 'day' is based on a calendar day, so should you use your pass at 4pm on Monday, Monday is counted as day one of your pass usage.

What you can see?

You may use your Paris Pass to visit as many attractions as you like within one day, however you may only visit each attraction once within that day. You may revisit most **attractions** on following days but the voucher elements within your Paris Pass, included is the Bateaux Parisiens River Cruise, which can only be redeemed once.

Remember: Paris Pass holders get the luxury of skipping the lines.
The Paris Pass does not permit access to temporary exhibitions or guided visits.
