<p><u>Monkeyland, Birds of Eden and Jukani Wildlife Sanctuary</u> Monkeyland: Monkeyland Primate Sanctuary is the world's first multi species, free roaming primate sanctuary providing ex-captive primates with a healthier, more natural life. Around 500 apes, monkeys and lemurs live at Monkeyland including gibbons, langurs, saki, capuchin, squirrel, vervet, howler and spider monkeys along with black and white ruffed and ring-tailed lemurs in 12 hectares of pristine indigenous forest.</p> <p>Birds of Eden: Birds of Eden is the largest single dome free flight aviary in the world. The sanctuary encompasses an area of over 2 hectares of natural forest and waterways, criss-crossed by some 1.2km of walkways. Visitors here are welcome to explore at their own pace with the aid of the Birds of Eden specialised guidebook or with one of the experienced guides. Birds of Eden is home to some 3500 birds comprising of almost 220 species all of whom have the freedom to fly, forage and swim.</p> <p>Jukani: Jukani Wildlife Sanctuary is home to rescued apex predators including all of the 'big' cats such as jaguars, lions, tigers and leopards.
