<p>AGRA FULL DAY CITY TOUR AND FATEHPUR SIKRI</p> <p>Visit the world famous Taj Mahal (Friday closed) built by Shah Jahan in 1653 in memory of his queen Mumtaz Mahal to enshrine her mortal remains. This architectural marvel is a perfectly proportioned masterpiece fashioned from white marble that stands testimony to the skill of 20,000 craftsmen brought together from Persia, Turkey, France and Italy and who took 22 years to complete this 'Love Poem in Marble'. Later visit the Agra fort containing the halls of private & public audiences & other palaces. Shah Jahan spent here years of confinement at the hands of his son Aurangzeb, looking wistfully at the Taj Mahal from the Fort. Later visit The magnificent fortified ghost city of Fatehpur Sikri was built by Emperor Akbar in 1569 as his capital and abandoned 15 years later, allegedly due to a severe scarcity of water. You will visit the graceful buildings within such as the Jami Masjid, the tomb of Salim Chisti, the Panch Mahal, Diwan I Khas and other palaces. It is a place where Islamic architecture fuses with Hindu and Jain decorative art.</p>	Daily	Full Day	INR 3750.00
<p>MUMBAI HALF DAY CITY TOUR</p> <p>On a half day city tour, visit the Prince of Wales Museum built in grand Indo Saracenic style, drive past Marine Drive, Mumbai's most popular seaside promenade, and see the Kamla Nehru Park and Hanging Gardens on the slopes of the Malabar hills, offering a nice view of the marine lines and the Chowpatty beach. Visit the Jain temple, Mani Bhawan where Mahatma Gandhi used to stay, and the Dhobi Ghat. Also, drive past the Flora Fountain, the colourful Crawford Market and Victoria Terminus train station.</p>	Daily	Half Day	INR 2625.00
<p>FULL DAY OLD AND NEW DELHI CITY TOUR</p> <p>Full day sightseeing of Old and New Delhi. In Old Delhi drive past the Red Fort a marvel in red sandstone, the Raj Ghat, memorial to Mahatma Gandhi, Jama Masjid, the largest mosque in India. Proceed to Chandni Chowk to savour the ambience of an oriental, crowded bazaar. Continue to New Delhi; pass by India Gate (memorial to the Indian army soldiers who died in the World War I), the Rashtrapati Bhavan (formerly the viceroy's residence), and the Parliament House. Visit the imposing Lakshmi Naryan Temple, see the 12th century Qutab Minar - gracefully hand-carved for its entire height of 234ft, and the Ashoka iron pillar which has withstood the ravages of time and not rusted even after 1500 years and the mausoleum of emperor Humayun a forerunner of the Mughal style of architecture. <p>JAIPUR HALF DAY CITY TOUR</p> <p>Take a half-day tour of the city visiting the Maharaja's City Palace and the Jantar Mantar Observatory. Jaipur's walled City Palace (1732 AD) occupies one-seventh of the city's area. See the Mubarak Mahal, museums of textiles and armoury etc, and the Diwan I Khas and Diwan I Am.
