<p><b>HALF DAY CITY TOUR</b></p> <p>A tour through the city, visiting the residential areas of Higienópolis with its 1950's apartment buildings; Pacaembu Soccer Stadium; Tour will continue passing by Ibirapuera Park with beautiful gardens, lakes and important venues. At the entrance to the park, visitors will admire São Paulo's postcard monument - Bandeirantes, homage to the first settlers. This monument was sculpted on site by Victor Brecheret in the late 40's / 50's. To the left of this monument the Chamber of Deputies building. An integral part of the park - the obelisk - monument to the Constitutionalist Revolution Soldier, a mausoleum in memory of the republicans that were killed in the 1932 revolution. Also part of the park, Planetarium and the Contemporary Art Museum and the São Paulo Biannual Art Exposition site. Tour will move on to the Oriental District - where the Japanese have their commerce, being close to São Paulo's Cathedral. You will also pass by the Anhangabaú Valley - downtown bustling São Paulo, Municipal Theatre (Ramos de Azevedo Square), Luz Train Station, Banco do Brasil Cultural Center, São Paulo Stock Exchange, Banespa Tower / Martinelli Building (1st skyscraper in SP), São Bento Monastery, Pátteo do Colégio (São Paulo's birthplace), Sé Cathedral.</p>	DAILY	4 Hours	US\$135
<p><b>FULL DAY COFFEE PLANTATION WITHOUT TICKET</b></p> <p>Campinas is a thriving town 100km from São Paulo. In the first half of the 19th century, Campinas became a growing population centre, with many coffee and sugarcane farms. We will learn a little bit about the history, visiting a local coffee farm, where local guides will show the techniques and all the stages from the plantation to the crop. <p><b>SANTOS &amp; GUARUJA TOUR</b></p> <p>The port of Santos was one of the first in Brazil, founded approximately in 1535, the same year that was built the church of Santa Catarina. Our ride takes us to the biggest port of Brazil (with more than 20 Km of pier facilities) through the most important residential areas and along the beaches of Gonzaga and São Vicente. Leaving from the Port of Santos and driving along the 30 km Piaçaguera highway, tour reaches Guarujá. A long-standing favourite resort for Paulistas (inhabitants of São Paulo state and capital), Guarujá has not become a beach resort by chance, it was planned to offer tourists the best possible welcome. The urban planning of the city, with its pedestrian streets, large tree lined beachfront avenues is a clear translation of the commitment of the city as a vacation resort. Vehicles will leisurely pass by downtown and the beaches of Asturias, Tombo, meaning Fall for its rough surf and a surfer's haunt. Enseada a 6 km long beach with clear blue calm waters. Pernambuco, a beach with sophisticated summer homes and Perequê with a variety of seafood kiosks where one can buy oysters and skewered shrimps. Lunch not included.</p>	On request	Full Day	US\$255
