Rum Shed:	Known as the “Social Hubs” of Mauritius, rum shops are the equivalent to UK pubs, where locals meet for a drink with friends to discuss everything from sports to politics and world affairs. Echoing these shops, the “shabby – chic” Rum Shed at Shanti Maurice captures the essence of a bygone era, with tavern – like windows and doors and delightfully old – school décor. Its walls are lined with wood planks from old fishing boats and tables and chairs are made out of bicycle rims, while 50 – gallon oil drums act as hanging light fixtures. The bar offers the largest collection of rums in Mauritius, with over 180 types from 36 countries, all displayed in vintage cupboards. There's an impressive selection of rum – based cocktails and beside the usual bar snacks, guests have the possibility to experience the so called “Comfort Food” freshly made in a kitchen which is built in an old shipping container.

Location:
Located around a pristine horseshoe coral sand cove, on the largely untouched south coast of Mauritius, Shanti Maurice is spread over 36 acres of tropical gardens, surrounded by sugar-cane fields, lush hills and the turquoise Indian Ocean.

The island of Mauritius basks in an all-year-round sub-tropical climate. The coastline is surrounded almost entirely by coral reefs and dramatic mountains rise above the extinct volcanic craters, rivers and waterfalls of the island's central plateau.

Access:

Daily direct flights from Europe with Air Mauritius, Virgin Atlantic, British Airways and Emirates. The resort is 35 kilometres or a 40-minute drive from the airport.
