<p>City Spectacular: Abu Dhabi City tour</p>	<p>This comprehensive tour is the ideal introduction to the city and the island on which it stands.</p> <p>We begin with our first stop at the impressive Grand Mosque - named after His Highness Sheikh Zayed Bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the late President of the UAE. It is one of the largest mosques in the world, able to accommodate more than 30,000 worshippers. We then drive to the Abu Dhabi Cultural Foundation, followed by a visit to the vegetable, date, fish and Iranian markets in Port Zayed.</p> <p>Driving along the spectacular Corniche, with its gleaming white mosques and elegant high-rise apartments, we stop at the Heritage Village, which houses a small museum that depicting the traditional daily activities of the Arab community before the discovery of oil. <p>Silk, Spices and Gold: Dubai City tour</p>	<p>We head north-east to Dubai - Abu Dhabi's neighboring emirate for a day of exploring. Arriving at the historic Dubai Creek, we walk through the Bastakiya area, a cluster of beautiful, carefully restored old wind-towered houses. We visit the 150 year old Al Fahidi Fort, which houses Dubai's Museum. We continue our journey across the Creek by Abra (water taxi) and after a short walk we are in the exotic spice souk, with its exquisite array of oriental and Middle Eastern spices. Winding our way through the alleys of the spice souk, we enter Dubai dazzling gold souk allowing time to browse and buy.</p> <p>Our next stop is Souk Al Bahar, a vibrant arabesque dining, shopping and entertainment experience located in the heart of the prestigious Downtown Burj Dubai area. After a brief stop for lunch (for own account) we head to the Jumeirah Mosque and Burj Al Arab for photo opportunities before our drive back to Abu Dhabi.</p> <p><i>This full day tour operates on Sunday and Thursday</i></p>	<p>1 Nov'11 – 31 Oct'12 \$59.00</p>
<p>Falcon World - Encounter with a Winged wonder</p>	<p>This tour of the world's largest Falcon Hospital is a rare opportunity to explore the world of falconry. One of nature's most awe-inspiring birds of prey, the Falcon has always played a prominent role in the history and culture of the Middle East.</p> <p>We drive to the Abu Dhabi Falcon Hospital where our first stop is the Falcon Museum. Get acquainted with the history of falconry, as well as tools and equipment associated with the sport. This tour will give you an insight into falcon registration and their unique falcon passports - an essential document, because falcons must travel with their owners and are prohibited from being kept in storage on a UAE flight. At our next stop, the Examination Room, we will see falcons undergo routine check-ups and treatment and learn about the most common ailments affecting these birds. We tour the Intensive Care Unit, a state-of-the-art facility that can identify even the rarest avian diseases. The tour concludes outside the hospital where guests can take pictures of falcons, pose for photos with a falcon perched on their arm and watch falcons fly in a large free-flight aviary.</p> <p><i>Female guests on this tour are advised to wear conservative attire covering the shoulders, arms and knees.
