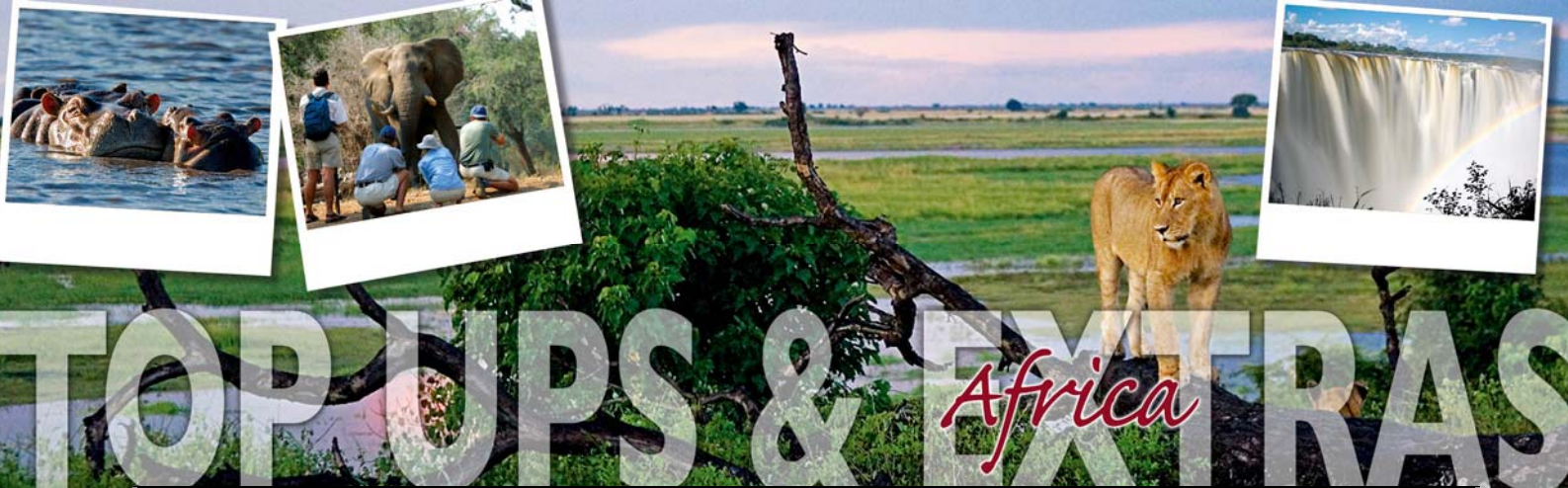

<p><b>Livingstone Island</b></p>	<p>David Livingstone, the missionary explorer, viewed the Mosi-Oa-Tunya, the Smoke that Thunders, from Livingstone Island, on 16 November 1855. Livingstone Island can most certainly be classed as one of the most awesome picnic spots in the world and is well worth a visit. From August to December guests can swim in the rock pool on the edge of the Falls, so it is recommended that you bring swimming gear. Choose from a morning tour, lunch tour or a tea tour to Livingstone Island. The tours will operate all year round, even when it is raining and may only be cancelled due to very heavy storms.
