| Countryside Tour | The Countryside Tour takes you to the outskirts of Kuala Lumpur city, along the Ambassador Row. The tour passes by Istana Sharif Ali and some small village clusters of Malay houses. We will have the first stop at the Royal Selangor Pewter Factory, featuring the largest and most modern pewter factory in the world, reputed internationally for its high quality products and craftsmanship. Guests will be shown the different processes of pewter making such as casting, filling, polishing, soldering, hammering and engraving during this tour. Next stop is the Batik factory to see how batik is design and printed. Following this will a short journey to the limestone hills of Batu Caves which comprises of three main caverns and several other smaller caves. Inside the main cave lies the shrine of a Hindu diety, Lord Murugah. To reach the shrine, guests would have to climb 272 steps leading up to the Temple cave. Duration: 3.5hrs | 71.28 |
