| City Tour of Bangalore We will visit the Dutch Palace which is also known as Mattancherry Palace which is built by the Portuguese and presented to the Raja of Cochin in 1555 AD. It has acquired its name after 1663 when the Dutch carried out extensions and repairs on the palace. At no point in time did the Portuguese or the Dutch stay there. The Interiors are decorated with murals from the Ramayana and there are some lively displays of royal costumes and palanquins. (Closed on Fridays and Jewish Holidays) We continue on to the Jewish Synagogue which was built in 1568 AD. The great Scrolls of the old Testament, as well as the copper plates in which the grants of privilege made by the Cochin rulers were recorded and the exquisite Chinese hand painted tiles are of interest (Closed on Fridays, Saturdays, and Jewish Holidays) We also visit the ST Francis Church which was built by the Portuguese in 1510 AD and believed to be the oldest church built by the Europeans in India. Vasco Da Fama was initially buried here and 14 years later his mortal remains were taken to Portugal. | Daily | Half day | \$108.00 |
