| <p>Athens Sightseeing including Acropolis Museum (SIC)</p> <p>The striking contrast between breath-taking monuments of a glorious past and modern elegant structures is what you will enjoy during your tour of Athens. Visit the Acropolis, the crowning beauty and glory of Ancient Athens, with its many monuments atop its rocky base, including the awesome Parthenon, the Propylea, the temple of Athena Nike and the Erechtheion, with its Porch of Maidens.</p> <p>Visit the Roman Temple of Olympic Zeus, short stop for photos of the Panathinaikon Stadium (site of the first modern Olympic Games in 1896), drive at the Tomb of the unknown Soldier in front of the Parliament House on Constitution Square. | <p>One Day Cruise to Hydra Aegna & Paros (SIC)</p> <p>Cruise across the crystal-blue Aegean on a private luxury speedboat to the stunning island of Hydra, enjoying swim stops at secluded beaches reachable only by sea, with light snacks and drinks served on board as you relax in the sun. Explore Hydra’s charming, car-free harbor town, where marble lanes, donkeys, and grand stone mansions create a timeless atmosphere that has inspired artists for decades. Wander through Plaka’s charming old quarter with its neoclassical buildings and narrow lanes, pausing at a lively streetside café to sample olives, aromatic cheeses, and cured meats. | <p>Mykonos City & Island Tour (SIC) Discover the charm of Mykonos on a relaxed walk through the narrow lanes of Chora, where you'll see the iconic windmills, Little Venice, and learn how the town's whitewashed Cycladic architecture reflects its history and traditions. Continue by bus across the island, passing famous beaches, traditional fishing boats, small chapels, and classic island homes before reaching the peaceful village of Ano Mera to explore its square and the 16th-century Panagia Tourliani Monastery.
