Moscow City Tour by Car During this tour you will see the city centre of Moscow and get an impression of the history, architecture and main landmarks of the city. There will be some short stops for taking photographs. You will visit the famous Red Square that is the heart of Moscow, where you will enjoy a unique architectural complex of one of the largest squares in the world, St. Basil's Cathedral, History Museum, The Kremlin Lenin's mausoleum and the Trading Arcades of GUM. Other places that you will see during the tour: Christ the Saviour Cathedral that is a symbol of Russia's spiritual revival, Moscow State University campus with its panorama platform on Vorobiovy (Sparrow) Hills, Moscow's boulevards, a historical and cultural centre of Moscow with its museums, theatres and memorial places, the Theatre square and the world famous Bolshoi Theatre. Moscow by Night Private Tour Discover the unique atmosphere of Moscow at night. It is not just a place of great cultural legacy, but a vast, vibrant, vital city where lights shine 24-hour a day. During night time it is so attractive with all the lights and decorations. Day trip to Vladimir & Suzdal This is a private excursion to the beautiful towns of the Golden Ring, Suzdal and Vladimir. The sightseeing will enable you to see the UNESCO World Heritage sites in Suzdal and Vladimir. Suzdal dates back to at least the year 1024 and it is a religious centre with numerous monasteries. The distinctiveness of Suzdal is in the fact that retains the look and feel of a small village with streams and several city streets still unpaved. Includes: Lunch	Thu, Fri, Sat & Sun	12 Hours
Kremlin, Cathedral & Armoury Tour The Moscow Kremlin is not just a historical fortification. This is the heart of Russia; the main spiritual and political centre of the country; her pride and glory; the official residence of the President of the Russian Federation. It is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site. During the excursion you will visit the Cathedral Square and temples: The Assumption Cathedral, where Russian emperors were crowned, the Archangel Cathedral - the tomb of the grand dukes, the Annunciation Cathedral, Ivan the Great Bell Tower and the Patriarch's Chamber, appreciate the grandeur of the Tsar Bell and Tsar Cannon. The Armoury Chamber is one of the oldest Russian Museums, it contains the collection of precious items that had been preserved for centuries in the tsars' treasury and the patriarch's vestry. Highlights include the shrine covers of Tsarevich Dmitri and St Cyril (Kirill) of Belozersk and a collection of Faberge eggs, Turkish and Persian weapons from the 15th to 19th century, the Olympic Tea-Set which was given to Emperor Alexander I by Napoleon, the Golden Cap and many more. Pushkin Fine Arts Museum Tour On this tour, you will visit Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts and enjoy a collection of foreign art dating back to ancient times, right up to modern day. The tour finishes at the museum.	Daily - except Monday	3½ Hours By car By Metro
