<p>St. Petersburg City Tour St. Petersburg is a city with a lot to show. During your city-tour you will pass by the main attractions and iconic sites such as St. Isaak's Cathedral, Peter and Paul Fortress, Bronze Horseman, Cruiser "Aurora", the Hermitage. <p>Russian Museum Tour The State Russian Museum contains the world's largest collection of Russian fine art. It was opened in 1898. The collection of the Russian Museum total more than 400,000 exhibits. All genres and schools of fine, applied and folk art from the 10th to the 20th century is presented in the museum. The main complex of museum buildings - the Mikhailovsky Palace and Benois Wing - houses the permanent exhibition of the Russian Museum.</p>	Daily - except Tuesday	2½ Hours By car By Metro
<p>Hermitage Tour The State Hermitage Museum is a museum of art and culture and the second largest museum in the world. If you spend a minute to see each item you will need 5.5 years to finish the inspection. Originally the Hermitage was a private collection of 200 canvases owned by Catherine The Great. The interiors of the palace themselves impress greatly. Hermitage collection included two paintings by Leonardo da Vinci and a sculpture by Michelangelo, which can be found nowhere else in Russia, as well as the largest collection of Rembrandt's paintings outside Netherlands.</p>	Daily - except Mondays	4 Hours By car By Metro

City Tour including Peter & Paul Fortress & Church of the Spilt Blood

During this city tour you will see the major architectural and historical attractions such as the Palace Square, the Winter Palace (former residence of Russian Tsars), St. Isaac's Square, Decembrists' Square, the Square of Arts, the Field of Mars, the Summer Garden, the Marble Palace, Michael's Castle, the cruise Aurora, the Spit of Basil's Island.

Visit Peter & Paul Fortress located on small Hare Island, the historic core of the city and named after the Cathedral of Peter and Paul located inside the fortress. 13 members of the royal family are buried there, including Peter the Great and Catherine the Great. You will have views of the Hermitage and the Admiralty and will also pass by Nevsky Prospect - the main boulevard of St Petersburg.

Visit Spilled Blood Cathedral (also known as Church of Our Saviour), one of the most beautiful cathedrals in St Petersburg and constructed in the style of the 16th - 17th century Russian architecture. The Cathedral stands out for its complicated and picturesque outline, as well as for its rich and multi-coloured decoration.
