Polonnaruwa The ruined capital of Polonnaruwa is one of the undisputed highlights of the cultural triangle and is also a UNESCO world heritage site. The heyday of the city in the twelfth century is represented in one of the high watermarks of early Sri Lankan civilization.  Polonnaruwa's extensive and well-preserved remains offer a fascinating snapshot of medieval Sri Lanka, including some of the island's finest monuments.  The Gal Vihara a collection of magnificent Buddha statues carved out of sheer rock is not to be missed.	Daily	Half day
Single Tree Hill Single tree Hill / One tree hill mountain is the tenth highest peak in Sri Lanka (2100 meters) above Nuwara Eliya city.  Single tree hill is easily accessible by use of the road across the tea estate.  Single Tree Hill mountain is one of the most panoramic vantage points of Nuwara Eliya which gives an extraordinary view of the city below.  You can take the view in of Haggala mountain, Pidurutalgala range, Lake Gregory and the whole of the northern slice of Horton plains.
