## DINING PLANS 2020

Disney Dining Plans are only available to guests staying in a Walt Disney World Hotel.

### Disney Quick Service Dining Plan

Includes the following: Two (2) Quick Service meals and two (2) Snacks per person (ages 3 +) per night during the package stay at participating Disney Resort hotel and Theme Park locations. Participating restaurants are subject to change. This plan also includes one (1) Resort refillable drink mug per person (ages 3 +). The duration of the Disney Quick Service Dining Plan must coincide with the number of nights of the room reservation. Meals for guests ages 3-9 may not be used by persons ages 10 and up. Guests ages 3-9 must order from the children's menu where available.

**Quick Service Meals:** Each Quick Service Meal includes one (1) single serving:

- **For Breakfast:**
  - Entrée or Combo meal (if available)
  - Beverage
- **For Lunch/Dinner:**
  - Entrée or Combo meal (if available)
  - Beverage

**Snacks:** Examples of snacks\* include a choice of:

- Frozen Ice-Cream Novelty, Popsicle or Fruit Bar
- Popcorn Scoop (single serving size)
- Single piece of whole fruit
- Single-serving Bag of Snacks
- 20 oz. Bottle of Coke, Diet Coke, Sprite or Dasani Water
- Medium Fountain Soft Drink
- 12 oz. Coffee, Hot Chocolate or Hot Tea
- Single-serving Pre-packaged Milk or Juice

\*Alcoholic beverages are not included.





Where “beverage” is included for quick service meals, the guest may choose any non-alcoholic beverage, or, if beer, wine or mixed drink beverages are offered at the location and the guest is 21 years of age or older with acceptable proof of age (see below), the guest may choose from a selection of the beer, wine or mixed drinks available at the location. Such selection will include most of the total offering of beer, wine or mixed drinks available at the location; some beer, wine and mixed drinks will be excluded. Novelty or souvenir cups are not included.

The Resort refillable drink mug entitles guest to refills of fountain soda from quick service restaurants in the Resorts during the Guest’s stay. Mugs are not eligible for fills or refills in Theme Park, Water Park or Disney Springs locations.

#### **Disney Dining Plan**

**Includes the following: One (1) Table Service meal, one (1) Quick Service meal, and two (2) Snacks** per person (ages 3 +) per night during the package stay at participating Disney Resort hotel and Theme Park locations. Participating restaurants are subject to change. This plan also includes one (1) Resort refillable drink mug per person (ages 3 +). The duration of the Disney Dining Plan must coincide with the number of nights of the room reservation. Meals for guests ages 3-9 may not be used by persons ages 10 and up. Many dining locations require the redemption of two (2) Table Service meals per guest (these locations are referred to as “Signature Restaurants”). Also, an entrée, prix fixe offering, or any other offering with a menu price which exceeds \$40.00 (\$75.00 in the case of Signature Restaurants) may not be available for a Disney Dining Plan Table Service meal without payment of a surcharge. Guests ages 3-9 must order from the children’s menu where available. Applicable gratuities are not included.

Due to the popularity of our Disney table service restaurants, dining availability may be limited or not available without advance reservations. Guests can call 407-WDW-DINE to make reservations up to 180 days prior to their visit, subject to availability.

#### **Disney Deluxe Dining Plan**

Participating restaurants are subject to change. This plan also includes one (1) Resort refillable drink mug per person (ages 3 +). The duration of the Disney Deluxe Dining Plan must coincide with the number of nights of the room reservation. Meals for guests ages 3-9 may not be used by persons ages 10 and up. Many dining locations require the redemption of two (2) Table Service meals per guest (these locations are referred to as "Signature Restaurants"). Also, an entrée, prix fixe offering, or any other offering with a menu price which exceeds \$40.00 (\$75.00 in the case of Signature Restaurants) may not be available for a Disney Deluxe Dining Plan Table Service meal without payment of a surcharge.

#### General Provisions:

1. The Disney Dine Plan Add-On may only be purchased as a part of a Disney Hotel & Theme Park Ticket package.
2. If a Disney Dine Plan Add-On is purchased for any guest in the party, it must be purchased for all guests in the party ages 3 and over.
3. The Disney Dine Plan Add-On may not be accepted for Dining Events, Chef's Dinners, Special Dinners, or for any menus which are not available at all tables in the restaurant.
4. Items at a table service restaurant which are not sold separately may not be available for the Disney Dining Plan or the Disney Deluxe Dining Plan.
5. Florida law permits the sale and service of alcohol products only to persons 21 years of age or older. The operators of the Walt Disney World® Resort participate in Florida's Responsible Vendor program, and servers will verify age by requesting acceptable identification.

Acceptable forms of ID are : U.S. driver's license, U.S. state ID card, U.S. Military ID, or original passport or copy of passport (either on paper or captured on a mobile device), along with a government issued photo ID that can verify the person and date of birth shown on the passport. Please note all persons visit from outside of the United States are required to present both a valid passport as well as another form of government issued photo ID from their country of origin.
