<p>Discover Ba Na Hills – Da Nang Drive 45 minutes from Danang to Ba Na Hill. Located at an elevation of 1,487 meters, the temperature of this place is mostly cool year-round. Arrive at Ba Na Hills Station where you have a chance to ride on a modern system of cable cars. Get a bird's-eye view of nature which is strikingly beautiful, while enjoying a feeling of flying in the blue sky among the clouds and wind. Next, visit a theme park as well as a suspension bridge, Nui Chua and the Mountain Peak. Experience the feeling of walking in the clouds when you walk on the Golden Bridge which is supported by giant hands at a height of over 1,400m above sea level. After your lunch at a local restaurant with a great view, continue to explore Vong Nguyet villa (and its wine cellar), and Linh Ung Pagoda, Sakyamuni Buddha's monument. <p>City Highlights Tour (with cyclos) – Ha Noi Discover Hanoi, the “Paris of the East,” with its colonial architecture, leafy boulevards, and tranquil lakes. Visit key landmarks including the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, One Pillar Pagoda, Ho Chi Minh’s House, and the Temple of Literature, before exploring the Museum of Ethnology’s rich display of Vietnam’s diverse cultures. Enjoy a cyclo ride through the historic Old Quarter’s maze of narrow streets and conclude the day with a traditional water puppet performance, a unique art form from northern Vietnam.</p>	Daily, The Ho Chi Minh is closed every Monday & Friday	Full Day	USD 91 (Min 2 Pax)

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<p>Halong Bay Day Trip - Local Junk – Ha Noi Depart Hanoi for a 2hr drive to Halong Bay by new highway. A UNESCO Natural Heritage Site, Halong Bay covers an area of 43,400 ha including over 1,600 islands and islets, most of which are uninhabited and untouched. Halong (literally “where the dragon descends into the sea” in Vietnamese) is world renowned for its spectacular seascape of limestone pillars complemented by its biodiversity, home to 14 endemic floral species and 60 endemic faunal species. Board your traditional junk for a cruise amongst the stunning islets that soar from the clear emerald waters of the Gulf of Tonkin. Towering limestone pillars and tiny islets topped by forest along with wind- and wave-eroded grottoes add to the enchantment of this breathtakingly beautiful region. Enjoy a seafood lunch on board before returning to the wharf. Return to Hanoi arriving in the afternoon</p>	Daily	Full Day	USD 244 (Min 2 Pax)
<p>City Tour (With Pagoda & Temples) – Ha Noi Tour the city of Hanoi, with its ochre-coloured colonial buildings, tree-lined boulevards and scenic lakes. Visit the historic Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, an imposing monument of marble and granite built to house the preserved body of beloved revolutionary leader Ho Chi Minh, affectionately known to the Vietnamese as “Uncle Ho”. Tour the One Pillar Pagoda, a Buddhist temple built in 1049 of wood in the shape of a lotus blossom and set on a single stone pillar, considered by many to be one of Vietnam’s most iconic pagodas. Visit Ho Chi Minh’s House nearby, a simple wooden house in a tranquil setting where Ho Chi Minh lived and worked. Some of his belongings are on display and visitors can walk up the steps to see his bedroom. Continue to the 6th century Tran Quoc Pagoda, the oldest pagoda in Hanoi, located on a small island in West Lake. Conclude the tour with a visit to the 11th century Taoist Quan Thanh Temple featuring a mix of architectural styles from the imperial era and highlighted by a large yard shaded by a giant banyan tree and a shrine that contains a famous bronze statue of Tran Vu, one of the principal deities in Taoism.</p>	Daily	Half Day	USD 34 (Min 2 Pax)



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<p>Sunset Cruise (Local Boat) – Hoi An</p> <p>Sunset is just the start of a long day (and night) in the life of Hoi An’s fishermen. Board a local river boat for a sunset cruise while witnessing the town’s fishermen board their boats and head out to the Cua Dai Sea for a night of fishing. From the boat, you will see at first-hand the daily activities of the fishermen. The boat will stop along the shore where you can try your hand at casting traditional fishing nets, a common fishing method still practiced today. Also learn the art of paddling the unique Vietnamese round basket boats before heading back to the river boat. On the way back to town, enjoy a grilled sea food BBQ dinner as the sun disappears below the horizon.</p>	Daily	Half Day	USD 107 (Min 2 Pax)
<p>Island & Snorkelling Tour – Nha Trang</p> <p>Nha Trang is known for its fabulous year-round sunny weather, turquoise water, and a white sandy beach stretching the entire length of the city. Transfer to the pier and take a 45min cruise to Tam Island, named after the black rock formations, southeast of the island. Enjoy snorkelling (mask and a snorkel are provided on the boat) in the crystal-clear waters of this protected maritime reserve known for its vivid coral and diverse marine life, including a large diversity of nudibranchs, shrimps, crabs and cowries. Cruise to another island and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before making your way back to the pier and your hotel.</p>	Daily	Half Day	USD 114 (Min 2 Pax)

<p>Starting the ride in the busy city streets to a Cafe in central Saigon where we enjoy the morning coffee with the bird lovers before visiting the famous and thought invoking Burning Monk Memorial Statue. Our adventurous mix of historic landmarks and hidden treasures continues as we soak up the local culture at a fresh flower market and then a bright and vibrant fabric market. We zoom through Saigon traffic on the back of our comfortable Vespas to the captivating Chinese district, visiting a traditional medicine street with traditional medical herb shops, an ancient Buddhist temple and a hidden Chinese pagoda. Our final ride takes us into the heart of Saigon to see some classic city landmarks. Firstly, see the French architectural influences of the famous Saigon Post Office and beautiful Notre Dame Cathedral (outside only), before we end with a short history lesson outside the striking Independence Palace. Let our local guides show you their city, their Saigon.</p>
