<p>BANGKOK CITY & TEMPLES</p> <p>From several magnificent temples in Bangkok, the three most unique ones are Wat Traimit, Wat Pho and Wat Benchamabopit. Wat Traimit houses a striking 3-meter tall Golden Buddha image - a gleaming 5-ton figure of solid gold. Wat Pho, which features the largest reclining Buddha image in Thailand, and the Chedi of the kings, is Bangkok's oldest and largest temple. Finally there is Wat Benchamabopit, a fine modern Thai temple constructed from white Carrara marble with ornate crossbeams decorated with lacquer and gold.</p>	Daily	08:30 and 13:30 For 4.5 hours	THB 1315
<p>GRAND PALACE</p> <p>Visit the Grand Palace, one of the most beautiful samples of an ancient Siamese court. It used to be the residence of the Kings of Bangkok. Here you will see different palaces which were used for different occasions: the funeral Palace, the reception Palace, the Throne Hall, the Royal Guest House and Wat Phra Keo, the beautiful Emerald Buddha Temple. Please note that the Palace is closed during special royal ceremonies and during visiting heads of state.</p>	Daily	08:30 & 13:30 For 3 hours	THB 1705
<p>DAMNOEN SADUAK FLOATING MARKET</p> <p>There are countless floating markets throughout the country, many within a couple of hours of the capital. The colorfully clad merchants at these lively markets paddle along congested canals in sturdy canoes laden with fresh fruit and vegetables to sell to shoppers on the banks. There is lots of chatter and activity. Bargaining is common. That's all part of the fun -- but don't expect to get the price down more than a few baht. The most famous of the floating markets is Damnoen Saduak, about 100 kilometers southwest of Bangkok. This buzzing market is at its best in the early morning before the crowds arrive and the heat of the day builds up. Our tour further includes a visit to Phra Pathom Chedi in Nakorn Pathom, supposedly the largest pagoda in Southeast Asia.</p>	Daily	07h30 for 9 hours	THB 2580
<p>RIVER KWAI</p> <p>Fascinating, nostalgic and memorable sums up this day tour to Kanchanaburi province. The famous bridge and the beginning of the Death Railway is a poignant reminder of the thousands of POW's and forced labourers who lost their lives in the Second World War during the construction works of the railway. Transfer from your hotel in Bangkok to Kanchanaburi. Visit the Thailand-Burma Railway Museum, an interactive museum, information and research facility dedicated to presenting the history of the Thailand-Burma Railway. The fully air-conditioned centre offers the visitor an educational and moving experience. After a visit to the War Cemetery, enjoy a scenic long-tail boat trip along Maeklong River to the famous Bridge over the River Kwai. After lunch at a local restaurant, board the local train for the thrilling ride across wooden viaducts, which offer fantastic scenery along the Kwai River. <p>AYUTTHAYA BY BOAT (GRAND PEARL)</p> <p>Check-in at River City-counter Nr. 1 and depart by chartered coach from River City to Bang Pa-In, the former Summer Palace of King Rama V. Continue to Ayutthaya and visit Wat Sri Sanphet, Vihara Phra Mongkol Bophit and Wat Chai Wattanaram.
