Guests will visit the pyramids of Cheops, Chephran and Mycerinus, which the Greeks view as one of the Seven Wonders of the World. A single pyramid is built of 2 300 000 blocks, each weighing an average of two and a half tons. Not far from the Pyramids is the Great Sphinx of Giza, which dates from the time of Chephren (2620 BC).
