<p>All Amsterdam Transport Pass : This 24 hrs pass offers the perfect opportunity for travelling around Amsterdam. This pass is a combination of a 24 hrs pass on the wealth of waterways and a day pass to use on Public transport (tram, bus and underground). Combine these passes for a 24 hrs transport pass around the city during one day or use separately (this pass is valid for unlimited travel for one day for that mode of transport and will be stamped on first use). The comfortable boats offer a regular service along 3 routes with 14 stops altogether, located near the major museums, shopping areas and top attractions. <p>Combined City Tour, Volendam, Marken and Windmills : You will see all Amsterdam has to offer, from the historical monuments in the centre to the modern architecture of the 21st century. A picture stop at a windmill at the river Amstel and a visit to a diamond factory are included. We will also take you to the former Island of Marken. In this village you will visit a clog maker and explore this traditional Dutch village. Besides Marken we will also visit Volendam, where there is time for the Cheese factory and for lunch or shopping. Another part of the tour is the windmill village 'de Zaanse Schans', with its characteristic green wooden houses. On the turn of the 18th century this district was an industrial area with approximately 700 windmills in use. In this day and age there are only five left. <p>Amsterdam City Walking Tour : The guide will take you through the most famous parts of Amsterdam. You will walk through the popular neighbourhood, "de Jordaan". Where once the typical folk culture flourished in the narrow streets and small town houses. Then we move on to Dam Square and the magnificent palace, the real heart of Amsterdam. The "Begijnhof" an inner city court with dwellings from the 16th century, remains an interesting part of Amsterdam with its unique atmosphere. At the "Begijnhof" you will find the imposing and restored wooden house that dates back to 1528, one of the oldest houses in the Netherlands.
