<p><b>24 hours Hop-on Hop-off Lisboa</b></p> <p>The CitySightseeing Portugal hop on hop off is one of the best and most economical ways to see the city of Lisbon. This tour is operated by double-decker open-top buses offering an unobscured vision and privileged perspective of all the monuments on the tour. Discover the main sights and the beauty of this wonderful city. You can get on and off as many times as you wish, combining the two routes within the same ticket. Individual headphones provide a cultural commentary about the city's history and its monuments in 10 different languages (Portuguese, Spanish, French, English, German, Italian, Japanese, Dutch and Russian) and is with no doubt a fantastic way to discover the city of Lisbon in your own time.</p>	Daily	24 Hours	Adult <b>US\$26</b>
<p><b>Lisboa by Night with Fado Dinner Show</b></p> <p>The tour begins at your hotel where we pick you up and set off for the centre of the city. Here, discover the charm of the illumination of the leading Lisbon squares and boulevards: Marques de Pombal, Avenida da Liberdade, Rossio and Terreiro do Paco. We then head onwards as far as Belem. Here, there are graceful views out over the monuments honouring Portugal's golden era of exploration: Padrao dos Descobrimentos, Belem Tower, the Monastery of Jeronimos. Before dining, there is also time for views of the 25 de Abril Bridge and the Cristo Rei statue. <p><b>Full Day Fatima, Obidos, Nazare, Batalha &amp; Alcobac</b></p> <p>Tour depart first to encounter Obidos and meet its medieval walls, rustic white houses and the rich and varied local traditions of the town. The Tour then leave Obidos for Alcobaca to take in the imposing monastery church (UNESCO world heritage), the first Gothic church to be built in Portugal and home to the tombs of the ill-starred lovers D. <p>colorful fishing town of Nazare for lunch. Free time for lunch. There's also the chance to find out something about the legends and traditions of this town. When possible, we go to Sitio, to marvel at its wonderful views out over Nazare and its beaches. The tour then move onto Batalha to visit the monastery church (also UNESCO world heritage), a Gothic masterpiece with the most finely worked stained-glass windows. Finally, we reach the Our Lady of Fatima Sanctuary, an altar of the Christian faith and site of world pilgrimage. There is also the Chapel of Apparitions with its portrayal of Our Lady of Fatima. Take the time also for the location of the Basilica with the tombs of the three witnesses, and the Church of the Holy Trinity, the fourth largest in the world by capacity. You have some free time to attend mass. Travelling through this colorful agricultural region, we return to Lisbon.</p>			
<p><b>Full Day Lisbon and Sintra, Cascais &amp; Estoril</b></p> <p>A few hours to discover Lisbon, first of all we will visit the Belem quarter where you will find the most beautiful and historical monuments from the 15th and 16th centuries. A brief stop at the Belem Tower (Torre de Belem) - World Heritage by UNESCO - , point of departure of some of the Portuguese maritime explorations; and on the Monument to the Discoveries (Padrao dos Descobrimentos) , built to celebrate the 500th anniversary of the "death " of Prince Henry the Navigator. Then visit the Church of S. Jerome Monastery (Mosteiro dos Jeronimos) - World Heritage by UNESCO - a masterpiece of the "Manueline" style. Along the river we arrive at Alfama, an old and traditional district, where we will have the opportunity to walk in its narrow streets. Then We will pass by the downtown (Baixa) to admire the most important squares of Lisbon such as the monumental Trade Square (Praca do Comercio); Rossio Square, the heart of Lisbon and the symbolic Restauradores Square. Then we drive along the Liberdade Avenue, the "boulevard" of Lisbon, to finish at Marques de Pombal Square, admiring the statue of the 18th-century portuguese statesman responsible for Lisbon reconstruction after one of the most deadliest earthquakes in History, the 1755 Lisbon Earthquake. Spend some free time whether discovering the handicraft stores or the famous sweets of Sintra. The tour then head onto Cabo da Roca (the most westerly point of Europe) before continuing along the coast, passing by the famous Guincho beach until arriving at Cascais. wave feature and the magnificent panorama over Cascais Bay and the adjoining coastline. On the way back to Lisbon, we pass by Estoril, home to the famous Casino and its lovely gardens.
